PLEASE DO NOT SUBMIT ENTRIES PRIOR TO JANUARY 31, 2012
APPLICATION DEADLINE: Entries must be postmarked on or before April 15, 2012

ELIGIBLE WORKS

1. Artists must be 18 years of age or older.
2. All works must be original creation of the artist – imaginative, creative and produced by YOU. Paintings; Oil, Acrylic Watercolor; Drawings; Prints; Sculpture; Pottery; Jewelry, Hand carved Wood; Leather; Metal; Leaded Glass; Photography and arts works considered to be in the Fine Arts category are acceptable.
3. Unacceptable to the show: No buy/sale in any category, gourmet foods, dealers, middlemen, crocheting, knitting, decoupage, candies or wearing apparel are not eligible to be exhibited. This is a show for the artists and not a show for commercialism or dealers. **FINAL INTERPRETATION OF COMMERCIAL STATUS WILL BE MADE BY THE ARTS IN THE PARK RULES COMMITTEE.**
4. This is a family oriented show. Please keep this in mind when you are choosing work to be displayed.

ELIGIBLE EXHIBITORS AND ENTRY FEE

5. The show will be limited to space available. Applications will be accepted until April 15, 2012. Applications will be juried and notice will be sent to you by April 30, 2012 An accepted application is a commitment to show and “NO REFUNDS” will be made for cancellation.
6. Spaces may be shared, however, each exhibitor must pay the entry fee regardless of space sharing. No group or organization may enter.
7. No exhibitor may swap or resell a space to another exhibitor. The Committee reserves the right to reassign your space if you have not checked in by 10 a.m. on Saturday.
8. This is an outdoor show. If severe weather hits, we will try to have an alternative indoor venue. No guarantee that one will be available, so please plan accordingly. Be prepared for rain or wind. If we are forced to move indoors we will make every effort to notify all exhibitors.
9. Fees: Application/Jury Fee is \$20.00 is **“NON REFUNDABLE”** and must be a separate check. Please send a photo that best represents your type and quality of work.. The Space Fee is \$50.00 refunded only if the applicant is not juried into the show. If you need electricity the space fee with electricity will be \$75.00. Spaces with electricity are limited and we will do our best to accommodate those requests on a first come first serve basis. **PLEASE WRITE (2) TWO CHECKS – one for jury fee and the other for the space fee. PLEASE SUBMIT BOTH CHECKS AND PHOTO ALONG WITH YOUR APPLICATION.**

SET UP AND PARKING

10. All spaces are approximately 10' X 10' and will be marked and pre-assigned. Display equipment may not extend beyond the boundary of assigned space (including stakes, weights or poles for tents, etc.) Directions to the location of the show, a list of local motels and campgrounds will be sent with your acceptance notice. Exhibitors will be expected to set up between 8 – 10 a.m. on Saturday, May 26, 2012.
11. You may load and unload your vehicle along the curb on the north or east side, and the parking spots are on the south side of the park. The food vendors will be parked on the west side of the park, so we must leave that space open..
12. Each exhibitor must provide display racks or tables for his or her work. Bring your own chairs. It is recommended to have an awning tent, so the spaces will be uniform to the attendees.
13. Please keep your display area as neat as possible. Park trees cannot be used for display purposes. **DISPLAY EQUIPMENT MAY NOT EXTEND BEYOND THE BOUNDARY OF ASSIGNED SPACE, INCLUDING STAKES AND POLES FOR TENTS, ETC.**
Cars or trucks may not be driven or parked on park property in the show area. This rule applies for set-up time also.

MISCELLANEOUS

14. .Coffee, juice and doughnuts will be available the morning of the show for the vendors.
15. Port-a-potties and/or park facilities will be available to the exhibitors during the show.
16. Food will be available during the show from concessions
17. The park is grass, but an old rug or carpet will help with dust within your space.

TAXES

18. Each exhibitor is responsible for collecting Iowa sales tax on all sales (and be aware of Iowa laws) made during the show. This tax should be added to the price of the items sold.

GENERAL

20. We are confident you will understand and abide by the rules, which we feel necessary to produce a top quality show. However, if you feel that you cannot or will not comply with certain of the rules, please refrain from registering for the show. Thank you for your support.
